

# Currency (Royal Australian Mint) Determination 2009 (No. 2)<sup>1</sup>

## 1 Name of Determination

This Determination is the *Currency (Royal Australian Mint) Determination* 2009 (No. 2).

#### 2 Commencement

This Determination commences on the day after it is registered.

## 3 Specification of coins

For subsection 13A (1) of the *Currency Act 1965*, each item in Schedule 1 specifies:

- (a) the denomination of a coin; and
- (b) the coin's:
  - (i) standard composition; and
  - (ii) standard weight and the allowable variation from that weight; and
  - (iii) dimensions; and
  - (iv) design.

#### 4 Application of Determination

The specifications in Schedule 1 do not affect any other determination of the specifications of a coin.
