1 Name of Determination

This Determination is the *Currency (Royal Australian Mint) Determination* 2009 (No. 6).

2 Commencement

This Determination commences on the day after it is registered.

3 Determination of standard weight, design and dimension

For subsection 13A (1) of the *Currency Act 1965*, each item in Schedule 1 specifies, for a coin having the denomination and standard composition mentioned in the item (being a coin whose denomination is specified, or taken to be specified, in the Schedule to the Act):

- (a) the coin's standard weight; and
- (b) the allowable variation from that standard weight; and
- (b) the coin's dimensions; and

(c) the coin's design.

4 Application of Determination

The specifications in Schedule 1 do not affect any other determination of the specifications of a coin.

(a) '1 OUNCE FINE SILVER'

(b) 'ONE DOLLAR'; and

(c) the designer's mark resembling the letters 'WP'

(d) an artist's representation of the Yellow-Footed Rock-Wallaby positioned over rocks facing right; and

(e) spinifex below and to the left of the Rock-Wallaby

(d) the monogram 'IRB'

Reverse design A design consisting of the inscriptions:

(a) '1 OUNCE FINE SILVER'

(b) 'ONE DOLLAR'; and

(c) the designer's mark resembling the letters 'WP'

And

(d) an artist's representation of the Yellow-Footed Rock-Wallaby positioned over rocks facing right; and

(e) Spinifex below and to the left of the Rock-Wallaby

Obverse design The inscriptions:

(a) 'ELIZABETH II'; and(b) 'AUSTRALIA 2010';

Surrounding

(c) an effigy of Queen Elizabeth II; and

(d) the monogram 'IRB'

Reverse design

A design consisting of the inscriptions:

- (a) '1/10 oz. 9999 Au'
- (b) 'TEN DOLLARS'; and
- (c) the designer's mark resembling the letters 'WP'

And

- (d) an artist's representation of the Yellow-Footed Rock-Wallaby positioned over rocks facing right; and
- (e) Spinifex below and to the left of the Rock-Wallaby
